Notice on Exam Sessions Provisions of the Rector

Considering the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic and the significant increase in infections recorded in December and in the first week of January 2022, the exam sessions in the January-March 2022 session will continue to be carried out in presence, **except** for students in condition of fragility or exemption from vaccination against COVID-19, positivity to COVID-19 or state of mandatory quarantine. Students have to send their motivated request according to the procedures already defined by each School. As regards the School of Human and Social Sciences, the request must be sent to the teacher. Erasmus students can contact their academic coordinators.

The programmed number of exam sessions will be always be ensured, even for students authorized to take the exam remotely. The remote examination sessions will be carried out in correspondence with the scheduled sessions in the presence.

Teachers unable to carry out the exam sessions will promptly notify their unavailability so to ensure their regular running.

It is recommended to comply with the current rules for access to university facilities, for which the use of the mask (FFP2 in the cases provided for) and the possession of the basic or reinforced green pass is required.
